(A) Reason for Requesting Funds

Lack of state matching funds for a federal/state eradication.

(B) Action Taken

Treated 5,250 acres with Foray 48B. Two applications - 1/2 gallon,
 24 BIU/acre/application.

(C) Results

5,250 acres were treated with Foray 48B, beginning April 20, 1992. The second application ended on April 29, 1992. The weather was perfect during and after the application. Over 300 moths were trapped in the spray block the previous year. Following the 1992 eradication effort, less than 30 moths were trapped with no new finds of egg masses. Egg masses were discovered in a new area of the county and will be treated in 1993 with Foray 48B at the rate of 1 gallon per acre (2 applications of 1/2 gallon per acre). A total of 1,937 acres are scheduled for treatment in 1993.
